

Civil Rights Data Collection (CRDC)

Part of the U.S. Department of Education, the CRDC collects data on key education and civil rights issues in the nation's public schools. It collects a variety of information on enrollment, programs and services, most of which is disaggregated into the subgroups of race/ethnicity, sex, limited English proficiency, and disability. In Washington state, school districts send this information directly to the Federal Office of Civil Rights. This data and process of collection is not managed by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI). This data is not made available for public posting until 3-4 years after the data is submitted by districts.
