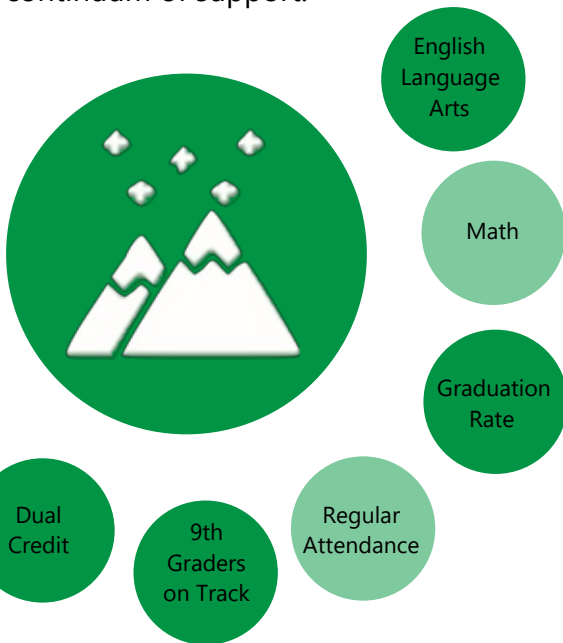

The Washington State Board of Education (SBE), the Educational Opportunity Gap Oversight and Accountability Committee (EGOAC), and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) developed a new recognition framework that incorporates state level and local information to identify schools that are exemplars in terms of growth and achievement.
