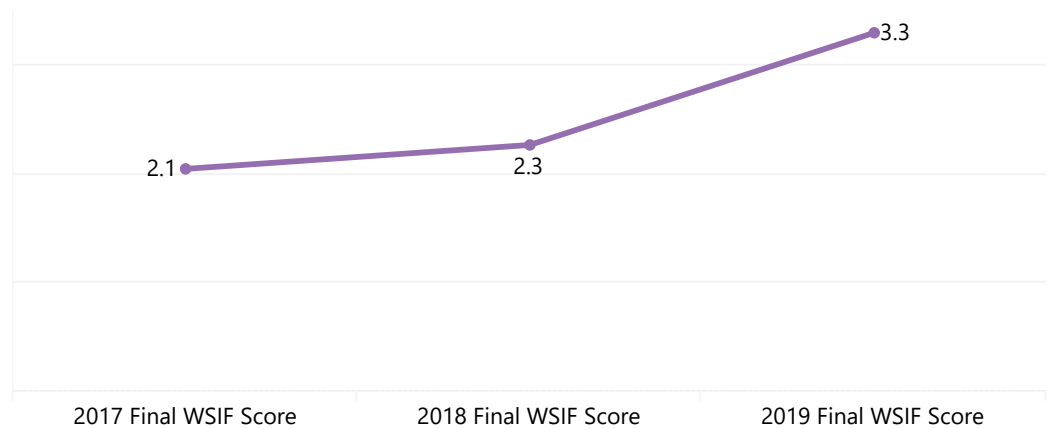

The Washington State Board of Education (SBE), the Educational Opportunity Gap Oversight and Accountability Committee (EGOAC), and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) developed a new recognition framework that incorporates state level and local information to identify schools that are exemplars in terms of growth and achievement. This new recognition framework identifies schools along the entire continuum of support.

Closing Gaps

Schools recognized for increasing their overall Washington School Improvement Framework (WSIF) score across all students are working to serve all students equitably. The schools are recognized for closing opportunity gaps for all students. Republic Junior High is recognized for improving their overall WSIF score for all students. Republic Junior High was initially identified for Comprehensive supports in 2017 with an overall WSIF score of 2.1 and has increased that score to 3.3 in the 2019 WSIF release.
