The Washington State Board of Education (SBE), the Educational Opportunity Gap Oversight and Accountability Committee (EGOAC), and the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) developed a new recognition framework that incorporates state level and local information to identify schools that are exemplars in terms of growth and achievement. This new recognition framework identifies schools along the entire continuum of support.

Schools recognized for increasing their graduation rates across all students are working to serve all students equitably. The schools are recognized for closing opportunity gaps for all students. Tekoa High School is recognized for increasing their graduation rate for all students. Tekoa High School was initially identified for Comprehensive supports in 2018 based on a low graduation rate. Tekoa High School is being recognized for improvements in the four-year graduation rate for All Students.
